Small Group notes for week beginning Trinity Sunday, 26 May 2013.

Bible passages: Romans 5:1-5; John 16:12-15 - "The community of the Spirit"

Welcome	Think of a time when a difficult school subject 'clicked' for you? How did it happen?
Worship ideas	Suggested songs: Songs of Fellowship 102 Father we love you, 334 Let your living water, 980 Praise God from whom all blessings flow, 1982 O God the God of blessing (NB: 20 files of newer songs are available to borrow from the lounge – eg ('You are good and your love endures forever' by Gareth Robinson or 'Our God saves' by Paul Baloche)
Word (refs.↓)	some suggestions for discussion here — you might prefer to focus on just 2 or 3 questions
Read Romans 5:1-5	What are the benefits Paul says are ours because of being justified through faith? Does he think of them as a present reality or as something to be hoped/ prayed for? What is your experience here? Trace the sequence in vv.3-4. Can you share any examples of suffering producing perseverance, character and hope? If you feel able, share what God has taught you through an experience of suffering. Compare v.5 with Galatians 4:6. How does God pouring the Spirit of his Son into our
	hearts provide us with assurance and hope?
Read John 16:12-15	V.12 "the Spirit will guide you into all truth" – including helping to understand the Trinity! • Do you find any of these 'analogies' of the Trinity helpful? – how are they 'like' and 'unlike' God as Trinity (a "Tri-Unity", three persons in one Godhead)? a. A tree – roots, trunk, branches (all essential aspects; without any it is not a tree, etc.) b. H2O - can be ice, water or steam - all are the same substance c. Egg – yolk, white, shell d. A person - who may be e.g. a husband, a father and a son all at the same time e. One of these symbols/ images (try looking at the last one through a circle eg a ring) [Rublev's Icon of the Trinity]
	f. Some other image that the group comes up with
	While none of these images/ models is perfect, try and take one and focus on its positive aspects - what does it say about who God is and how we can encounter him?
